- 3. Chardonnay
 - a) 2018 vintage
 - b) 2017 vintage & older
- 4. Sweet whites (any vintage)

REDS

- 5. Rose (any vintage)
- 6. Pinot Noir
 - a) 2018 vintage
 - b) 2017 vintage & older
- 7. Shiraz (any vintage)
- 8. Other red varieties and blends (any vintage)

*Note for judging purposes, classes may be divided into smaller categories (based on wine varietals or vintages) if sufficient entry numbers are received.



GALA DINNER PRESENTATION

The top 3 wines (based on judges' scores) of the following categories will be presented at the Gala Dinner and the top wine (based on judges' scores) will be presented with the category Trophy for the "Best Wine of the Category".

- 1. Sparkling Wine (any vintage) "The Webforce5 Trophy"
- 2. Other white varieties and blends (any vintage) "The Lancefield & Romsey Community Bank, Bendigo Bank Trophy"
- 3. Chardonnay (any vintage) "Classic Oak Trophy"
- 4. Pinot Noir (any vintage) "Multi-Color Corporation Trophy"
- 5. Other reds or blends (any vintage) "The Midland Insurance Brokers Trophy"
- 6. Shiraz (any vintage) "Macedon Ranges Vignerons Association Trophy"

Other awards presented at the Gala dinner:

The Laurie Williams Trophy: Judges' Choice for the "Best wine of the show". Sponsored by the Macedon Ranges Shire Council

The **Gordon Knight Trophy**: Awarded to the "Best winery of the show" judged by the overall average of score from each winery (that submit at least 3 wines for judging). *Sponsored by Vintessentials*

The **People's Choice "Plumm" Trophy**: People's choice for the "Best Wine of the Exhibition" as decided by those attending the evening



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) All classes are open for competition to all vignerons and wine makers who are members of the MRVA.
- 2) Each wine entered must be made from at least 85% Macedon Ranges grapes.
- 3) Each wine entered **must be from a commercial bottling run** prior to the time of delivery of exhibits. No unbottled samples can be entered into the show.
- 4) The full commercial name of each wine entered must be stated on the entry form.
- 5) A **minimum of 25 dozen of each wine entered** must be bottled at the time of entry. For the sparkling wine class the wine must have been tiraged for at least 9 months prior to the entry date and a minimum of 10 dozen must be disgorged prior to the exhibition.
- 6) **Two bottles of each wine** entered will be required for judging. All must be fully labelled unless not yet released (an adhesive hand written label with wine details should be attached to each bottle in this case).
- 7) If your wine is one of the top 3 selected wines in any class, up to two dozen bottles must be made available for the wine presentation dinner.
- 8) If required for the dinner, the relevant number of bottles of wine up to two dozen must be available for delivery to the venue on the morning of Friday 4th October. Wine will be paid for by the MRVA on receipt of a tax invoice from the winery at \$150 (inclusive of WET & GST). Tax invoices are required no later than two weeks post exhibition dinner.
- 9) There is no restriction on the number of entries in any one class but the same wine must not be entered more than once in any class, even if bottled under a different label.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judges will judge each class and on receipt of all result sheets applicable to any one class, the Panel Chair shall have the points totalled. He or She shall have the power to arbitrate the Awards. Judges will not have access to entries apart from the glasses placed in front of them by the stewards. Wines will be judged on a 100 point scale.

Awards will be made as follows:

Bronze Award	85 - 89 points
Silver Award	90 – 94 points
Gold Award	95 - 100 points

The Chief Steward shall have the power to disqualify or dismiss, as being not eligible for judging, any exhibit which, in their opinion, does not comply with regulations in every respect, and such disqualification shall be accepted as final.
